**Two divisions:** "A" Grade 3 and above, "B" Grade 4 and below.

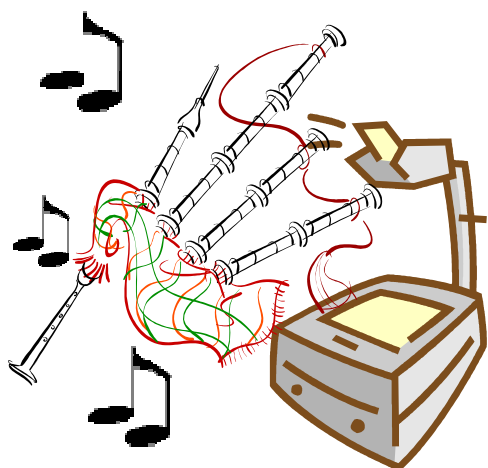
**Tune Requirements:** "A" Division Medley 4-6 minutes, "B" Division Medley 3-5 minutes.
